We cannot confirm vital records information without a formal request from an eligible individual.

You can submit a written request for a certified copy of this birth record, along with a photocopy of your state-issued drivers license or state identification card and the processing fee (\$10 for the first copy of the record, \$5 for each additional copy ordered at the same time) to:

We will search the state-wide vital records file for the record, based on the information you supply. If we are unable to locate a record on file, we will send you a "Not on File" letter. Per Georgia law, the \$10 fee is for the search of the record and is not refundable.

Please provide as much information as possible regarding the birth (Name at birth, birth date, county and city of birth, parents names, etc.). I hope this information is helpful. Thank you again for contacting our office.
