

## **“Judgment(s)” as found in the Old Testament of the King James Version of the Holy Bible**

The word “judgment(s)” is found in the OT 340 times, translated from 15 Hebrew words.

---

***Dâbâr*, Hebrew Strong’s #1697**, is a noun found 1439 times, translated as word (807), thing (231), matter (63), acts (51), chronicles (38), saying (25), commandment (20), *miscellaneous translations* (204). It is translated as “judgment” in the following verse:

**2 Chronicles 19:6** – And said to the judges, Take heed what ye do: for ye judge not for man, but for the LORD, who *is* with you in the judgment.

---

***Dîyn*, Hebrew Strong’s #1777**, is a verb found 24 times, translated as cause (1), **contend** (1), Execute (1), judge (14), judged (2), judgeth (1), judgment (1), plead (1), strife (1), strive (1). It is translated as “judgment” in the following verse:

**Psalms 9:8** - And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.

---

***Dîyn*, Hebrew Strong’s #1779**, is a noun found 18 times, translated as cause (8), judgment (7), plea (2), strife (1). It is translated as “judgment” in the following verses:

**Psalms 76:8** - Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still,

**Proverbs 20:8** - A king that sitteth in the throne of judgment scattereth away all evil with his eyes.

**Proverbs 31:5** - Lest they drink, and forget the law, and pervert the judgment of any of the afflicted.

**Esther 1:13** - Then the king said to the wise men, which knew the times, (for so *was* the king's manner toward all that knew law and judgment:

**Job 19:29** - Be ye afraid of the sword: for wrath *bringeth* the punishments of the sword, that ye may know *there is* a judgment.

**Job 35:14** - Although thou sayest thou shalt not see him, *yet* judgment *is* before him; therefore trust thou in him.

**Job 36:17** - But thou hast fulfilled the judgment of the wicked: judgment and justice take hold *on thee*.

**Isaiah 10:2** - To turn aside the needy from judgment, and to take away the right from the poor of my people, that widows may be their prey, and *that* they may rob the fatherless!

---

**Dîn, Hebrew Strong's #1780**, is a noun found 6 times, translated as judge (1), and judgment (5) in the following verses:

**Ezra 7:26** - And whosoever will not do the law of thy God, and the law of the king, let judgment be executed speedily upon him, whether *it be* unto death, or to banishment, or to confiscation of goods, or to imprisonment.

**Daniel 4:37** - Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works *are* truth, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase.

**Daniel 7:10** - A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.

**Daniel 7:22** - Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom.

**Daniel 7:26** - But the judgment shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy *it* unto the end.

---

**Ta'am, Hebrew Strong's #2940**, is a noun found 12 times, translated as advice (1), behaviour (2), discretion (1), judgment (1), reason (1), taste (5), understanding (1). It is translated as "judgment" in the following verse:

**Psalms 119:66** - Teach me good judgment and knowledge: for I have believed thy commandments.

---

**Mad, Hebrew Strong's #4055**, is a noun found 13 times, translated as armour (2), choicest (1), clothes (1), garment (3), garments (1), measure (1), measures (1), raiment (1), stature (1), and judgment (1) in the following verse:

**Judges 5:10** - Speak, ye that ride on white asses, ye that sit in judgment, and walk by the way.

---

**Mishpât, Hebrew Strong's #4941**, is a noun found 421 times, translated as judgment (296), manner (38), right (18), cause (12), ordinance (11), lawful (7), order (5), worthy (3), fashion (3), custom (2), discretion (2), law (2), measure (2), sentence (2), *miscellaneous translations* (18). It is translated as "judgment" in the following verses:

**Genesis 18:19** - For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.

**Exodus 21:1** - Now these *are* the judgments which thou shalt set before them.

**Exodus 21:31** - Whether he have gored a son, or have gored a daughter, according to this judgment shall it be done unto him.

**Exodus 23:6** - Thou shalt not wrest the judgment of thy poor in his cause.

### *Mishpât, Hebrew Strong's #4941 (continued)*

**Exodus 24:3** - And Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the judgments: and all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which the LORD hath said will we do.

**Exodus 28:15** - And thou shalt make the breastplate of judgment with cunning work; after the work of the ephod thou shalt make it; *of gold, of blue, and of purple, and of scarlet, and of fine twined linen*, shalt thou make it.

**Exodus 28:29** - And Aaron shall bear the names of the children of Israel in the breastplate of judgment upon his heart, when he goeth in unto the holy *place*, for a memorial before the LORD continually.

**Exodus 28:30** - And thou shalt put in the breastplate of judgment the Urim and the Thummim; and they shall be upon Aaron's heart, when he goeth in before the LORD: and Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel upon his heart before the LORD continually.

**Leviticus 18:4** - Ye shall do my judgments, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: I *am* the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 18:5** - Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: which if a man do, he shall live in them: I *am* the LORD.

**Leviticus 18:26** - Ye shall therefore keep my statutes and my judgments, and shall not commit *any* of these abominations; *neither* any of your own nation, nor any stranger that sojourneth among you:

**Leviticus 19:15** - Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment: thou shalt not respect the person of the poor, nor honour the person of the mighty: *but* in righteousness shalt thou judge thy neighbour.

**Leviticus 19:35** - Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment, in meteyard, in weight, or in measure.

**Leviticus 19:37** - Therefore shall ye observe all my statutes, and all my judgments, and do them: I *am* the LORD.

**Leviticus 20:22** - Ye shall therefore keep all my statutes, and all my judgments, and do them: that the land, whither I bring you to dwell therein, spue you not out.

**Leviticus 25:18** - Wherefore ye shall do my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them; and ye shall dwell in the land in safety.

**Leviticus 26:15** - And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, *but* that ye break my covenant:

**Leviticus 26:43** - The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul abhorred my statutes.

*Mishpâṭ, Hebrew Strong's #4941 (continued)*

**Leviticus 26:46** - These *are* the statutes and judgments and laws, which the LORD made between him and the children of Israel in mount Sinai by the hand of Moses.

**Numbers 27:11** - And if his father have no brethren, then ye shall give his inheritance unto his kinsman that is next to him of his family, and he shall possess it: and it shall be unto the children of Israel a statute of judgment, as the LORD commanded Moses.

**Numbers 27:21** - And he shall stand before Eleazar the priest, who shall ask *counsel* for him after the judgment of Urim before the LORD: at his word shall they go out, and at his word they shall come in, *both* he, and all the children of Israel with him, even all the congregation.

**Numbers 35:12** - And they shall be unto you cities for refuge from the avenger; that the manslayer die not, until he stand before the congregation in judgment.

**Numbers 35:24** - Then the congregation shall judge between the slayer and the revenger of blood according to these judgments:

**Numbers 35:29** - So these *things* shall be for a statute of judgment unto you throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

**Numbers 36:13** - These *are* the commandments and the judgments, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho.

**Deuteronomy 1:17** - Ye shall not respect persons in judgment; *but* ye shall hear the small as well as the great; ye shall not be afraid of the face of man; for the judgment *is* God's: and the cause that is too hard for you, bring *it* unto me, and I will hear it.

**Deuteronomy 4:1** - Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the statutes and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do *them*, that ye may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers giveth you.

**Deuteronomy 4:5** - Behold, I have taught you statutes and judgments, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that ye should do so in the land whither ye go to possess it.

**Deuteronomy 4:8** - And what nation *is there so great*, that hath statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day?

**Deuteronomy 4:14** - And the LORD commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and judgments, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go over to possess it.

**Deuteronomy 4:45** - These *are* the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which Moses spake unto the children of Israel, after they came forth out of Egypt,

**Deuteronomy 5:1** - And Moses called all Israel, and said unto them, Hear, O Israel, the statutes and judgments which I speak in your ears this day, that ye may learn them, and keep, and do them.

*Mishpât, Hebrew Strong's #4941 (continued)*

**Deuteronomy 5:31** - But as for thee, stand thou here by me, and I will speak unto thee all the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which thou shalt teach them, that they may do *them* in the land which I give them to possess it.

**Deuteronomy 6:1** - Now these *are* the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do *them* in the land whither ye go to possess it:

**Deuteronomy 6:20** - *And* when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What *mean* the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD our God hath commanded you?

**Deuteronomy 7:11** - Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them.

**Deuteronomy 7:12** - Wherefore it shall come to pass, if ye hearken to these judgments, and keep, and do them, that the LORD thy God shall keep unto thee the covenant and the mercy which he sware unto thy fathers:

**Deuteronomy 8:11** - Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day:

**Deuteronomy 10:18** - He doth execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment.

**Deuteronomy 11:1** - Therefore thou shalt love the LORD thy God, and keep his charge, and his statutes, and his judgments, and his commandments, *always*.

**Deuteronomy 11:32** - And ye shall observe to do all the statutes and judgments which I set before you this day.

**Deuteronomy 12:1** - These *are* the statutes and judgments, which ye shall observe to do in the land, which the LORD God of thy fathers giveth thee to possess it, all the days that ye live upon the earth.

**Deuteronomy 16:18** - Judges and officers shalt thou make thee in all thy gates, which the LORD thy God giveth thee, throughout thy tribes: and they shall judge the people with just judgment.

**Deuteronomy 16:19** - Thou shalt not wrest judgment; thou shalt not respect persons, neither take a gift: for a gift doth blind the eyes of the wise, and pervert the words of the righteous.

**Deuteronomy 17:8** - If there arise a matter too hard for thee in judgment, between blood and blood, between plea and plea, and between stroke and stroke, *being* matters of controversy within thy gates: then shalt thou arise, and get thee up into the place which the LORD thy God shall choose;

**Deuteronomy 17:9** - And thou shalt come unto the priests the Levites, and unto the judge that shall be in those days, and enquire; and they shall shew thee the sentence of judgment:

**Deuteronomy 17:11** - According to the sentence of the law which they shall teach thee, and according to the judgment which they shall tell thee, thou shalt do: thou shalt not decline from the sentence which they shall shew thee, *to* the right hand, nor *to* the left.

**Deuteronomy 24:17** - Thou shalt not pervert the judgment of the stranger, *nor* of the fatherless; nor take a widow's raiment to pledge:

**Deuteronomy 25:1** - If there be a controversy between men, and they come unto judgment, that *the judges* may judge them; then they shall justify the righteous, and condemn the wicked.

**Deuteronomy 26:16** - This day the LORD thy God hath commanded thee to do these statutes and judgments: thou shalt therefore keep and do them with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

**Deuteronomy 26:17** - Thou hast avouched the LORD this day to be thy God, and to walk in his ways, and to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and to hearken unto his voice:

**Deuteronomy 27:19** - Cursed *be* he that perverteth the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen.

**Deuteronomy 30:16** - In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

**Deuteronomy 32:4** - *He is* the Rock, his work *is* perfect: for all his ways *are* judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right *is* he.

**Deuteronomy 32:41** - If I whet my glittering sword, and mine hand take hold on judgment; I will render vengeance to mine enemies, and will reward them that hate me.

**Deuteronomy 33:10** - They shall teach Jacob thy judgments, and Israel thy law: they shall put incense before thee, and whole burnt sacrifice upon thine altar.

**Deuteronomy 33:21** - And he provided the first part for himself, because there, *in* a portion of the lawgiver, *was he* seated; and he came with the heads of the people, he executed the justice of the LORD, and his judgments with Israel.

**Joshua 20:6** - And he shall dwell in that city, until he stand before the congregation for judgment, *and* until the death of the high priest that shall be in those days: then shall the slayer return, and come unto his own city, and unto his own house, unto the city from whence he fled.

**Judges 4:5** - And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment.

**1 Samuel 8:3** - And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment.

*Mishpât, Hebrew Strong's #4941 (continued)*

**2 Samuel 8:15** - And David reigned over all Israel; and David executed judgment and justice unto all his people.

**2 Samuel 15:2** - And Absalom rose up early, and stood beside the way of the gate: and it was so, that when any man that had a controversy came to the king for judgment, then Absalom called unto him, and said, Of what city *art* thou? And he said, Thy servant *is* of one of the tribes of Israel.

**2 Samuel 15:6** - And on this manner did Absalom to all Israel that came to the king for judgment: so Absalom stole the hearts of the men of Israel.

**2 Samuel 22:23** - For all his judgments *were* before me: and *as for* his statutes, I did not depart from them.

**1 Kings 2:3** - And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

**1 Kings 3:11** - And God said unto him, Because thou hast asked this thing, and hast not asked for thyself long life; neither hast asked riches for thyself, nor hast asked the life of thine enemies; but hast asked for thyself understanding to discern judgment;

**1 Kings 3:28** - And all Israel heard of the judgment which the king had judged; and they feared the king: for they saw that the wisdom of God *was* in him, to do judgment.

**1 Kings 6:12** - *Concerning* this house which thou art in building, if thou wilt walk in my statutes, and execute my judgments, and keep all my commandments to walk in them; then will I perform my word with thee, which I spake unto David thy father:

**1 Kings 7:7** - Then he made a porch for the throne where he might judge, *even* the porch of judgment: and *it was* covered with cedar from one side of the floor to the other.

**1 Kings 8:58** - That he may incline our hearts unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and his statutes, and his judgments, which he commanded our fathers.

**1 Kings 9:4** - And if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, in integrity of heart, and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded thee, *and* wilt keep my statutes and my judgments:

**1 Kings 10:9** - Blessed be the LORD thy God, which delighted in thee, to set thee on the throne of Israel: because the LORD loved Israel for ever, therefore made he thee king, to do judgment and justice.

**1 Kings 11:33** - Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do *that which is* right in mine eyes, and *to keep* my statutes and my judgments, as *did* David his father.

**1 Kings 20:40** - And as thy servant was busy here and there, he was gone. And the king of Israel said unto him, So *shall* thy judgment *be*; thyself hast decided *it*.

**2 Kings 25:6** - So they took the king, and brought him up to the king of Babylon to Riblah; and they gave judgment upon him.

**1 Chronicles 16:12** - Remember his marvellous works that he hath done, his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth;

**1 Chronicles 16:14** - He *is* the LORD our God; his judgments *are* in all the earth.

**1 Chronicles 18:14** - So David reigned over all Israel, and executed judgment and justice among all his people.

**1 Chronicles 22:13** - Then shalt thou prosper, if thou takest heed to fulfil the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed.

**1 Chronicles 28:7** - Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do my commandments and my judgments, as at this day.

**2 Chronicles 7:17** - And as for thee, if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, and do according to all that I have commanded thee, and shalt observe my statutes and my judgments;

**2 Chronicles 9:8** - Blessed be the LORD thy God, which delighted in thee to set thee on his throne, *to be* king for the LORD thy God: because thy God loved Israel, to establish them for ever, therefore made he thee king over them, to do judgment and justice.

**2 Chronicles 19:8** - Moreover in Jerusalem did Jehoshaphat set of the Levites, and *of* the priests, and of the chief of the fathers of Israel, for the judgment of the LORD, and for controversies, when they returned to Jerusalem.

**2 Chronicles 19:10** - And what cause soever shall come to you of your brethren that dwell in their cities, between blood and blood, between law and commandment, statutes and judgments, ye shall even warn them that they trespass not against the LORD, and so wrath come upon you, and upon your brethren: this do, and ye shall not trespass.

**Ezra 7:10** - For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do *it*, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.

**Nehemiah 1:7** - We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.

**Nehemiah 9:13** - Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:

**Nehemiah 9:29** - And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

**Nehemiah 10:29** - They clave to their brethren, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the LORD our Lord, and his judgments and his statutes;

**Job 8:3** - Doth God pervert judgment? or doth the Almighty pervert justice?

**Job 9:19** - If *I speak* of strength, lo, *he is* strong: and if of judgment, who shall set me a time *to plead*?

**Job 9:32** - For *he is* not a man, as *I am*, *that* I should answer him, *and* we should come together in judgment.

**Job 14:3** - And dost thou open thine eyes upon such an one, and bringest me into judgment with thee?

**Job 19:7** - Behold, I cry out of wrong, but I am not heard: I cry aloud, but *there is* no judgment.

**Job 22:4** - Will he reprove thee for fear of thee? will he enter with thee into judgment?

**Job 27:2** - As God liveth, *who* hath taken away my judgment; and the Almighty, *who* hath vexed my soul;

**Job 29:14** - I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my judgment *was* as a robe and a diadem.

**Job 32:9** - Great men are not *always* wise: neither do the aged understand judgment.

**Job 34:4** - Let us choose to us judgment: let us know among ourselves what *is* good.

**Job 34:5** - For Job hath said, I am righteous: and God hath taken away my judgment.

**Job 34:12** - Yea, surely God will not do wickedly, neither will the Almighty pervert judgment.

**Job 34:23** - For he will not lay upon man more *than right*; that he should enter into judgment with God.

**Job 37:23** - *Touching* the Almighty, we cannot find him out: *he is* excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict.

**Job 40:8** - Wilt thou also disannul my judgment? wilt thou condemn me, that thou mayest be righteous?

**Psalms 1:5** - Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

*Mishpât, Hebrew Strong's #4941 (continued)*

**Psalm 7:6** - Arise, O LORD, in thine anger, lift up thyself because of the rage of mine enemies: and awake for me *to* the judgment *that* thou hast commanded.

**Psalm 9:7** - But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment.

**Psalm 9:16** - The LORD is known *by* the judgment *which* he executeth: the wicked is snared in the work of his own hands. Higgaion. Selah.

**Psalm 10:5** - His ways are always grievous; thy judgments *are* far above out of his sight: *as for* all his enemies, he puffeth at them.

**Psalm 18:22** - For all his judgments *were* before me, and I did not put away his statutes from me.

**Psalm 19:9** - The fear of the LORD *is* clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD *are* true *and* righteous altogether.

**Psalm 25:9** - The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way.

**Psalm 33:5** - He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.

**Psalm 35:23** - Stir up thyself, and awake to my judgment, *even* unto my cause, my God and my Lord.

**Psalm 36:6** - Thy righteousness *is* like the great mountains; thy judgments *are* a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.

**Psalm 37:6** - And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgment as the noonday.

**Psalm 37:28** - For the LORD loveth judgment, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.

**Psalm 37:30** - The mouth of the righteous speaketh wisdom, and his tongue talketh of judgment.

**Psalm 48:11** - Let mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of thy judgments.

**Psalm 72:1** - Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son.

**Psalm 72:2** - He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment.

**Psalm 76:9** - When God arose to judgment, to save all the meek of the earth. Selah.

**Psalm 89:14** - Justice and judgment *are* the habitation of thy throne: mercy and truth shall go before thy face.

**Psalm 89:30** - If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments;

**Psalm 94:15** - But judgment shall return unto righteousness: and all the upright in heart shall follow it.

**Psalm 97:2** - Clouds and darkness *are* round about him: righteousness and judgment *are* the habitation of his throne.

**Psalm 97:8** - Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah rejoiced because of thy judgments, O LORD.

**Psalm 99:4** - The king's strength also loveth judgment; thou dost establish equity, thou executest judgment and righteousness in Jacob.

**Psalm 101:1** - I will sing of mercy and judgment: unto thee, O LORD, will I sing.

**Psalm 103:6** - The LORD executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.

**Psalm 105:5** - Remember his marvellous works that he hath done; his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth;

**Psalm 105:7** - He *is* the LORD our God: his judgments *are* in all the earth.

**Psalm 106:3** - Blessed *are* they that keep judgment, *and* he that doeth righteousness at all times.

**Psalm 111:7** - The works of his hands *are* verity and judgment; all his commandments *are* sure.

**Psalm 119:7** - I will praise thee with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned thy righteous judgments.

**Psalm 119:13** - With my lips have I declared all the judgments of thy mouth.

**Psalm 119:20** - My soul breaketh for the longing *that it hath* unto thy judgments at all times.

**Psalm 119:30** - I have chosen the way of truth: thy judgments have I laid *before me*.

**Psalm 119:39** - Turn away my reproach which I fear: for thy judgments *are* good.

**Psalm 119:43** - And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I have hoped in thy judgments.

**Psalm 119:52** - I remembered thy judgments of old, O LORD; and have comforted myself.

**Psalm 119:62** - At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto thee because of thy righteous judgments.

**Psalm 119:75** - I know, O LORD, that thy judgments *are* right, and *that* thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me.

**Psalms 119:84** - How many *are* the days of thy servant? when wilt thou execute judgment on them that persecute me?

**Psalms 119:102** - I have not departed from thy judgments: for thou hast taught me.

**Psalms 119:108** - Accept, I beseech thee, the freewill offerings of my mouth, O LORD, and teach me thy judgments.

**Psalms 119:121** - I have done judgment and justice: leave me not to mine oppressors.

**Psalms 119:137** - Righteous *art* thou, O LORD, and upright *are* thy judgments.

**Psalms 119:156** - Great *are* thy tender mercies, O LORD: quicken me according to thy judgments.

**Psalms 119:160** - Thy word *is* true *from* the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments *endureth* for ever.

**Psalms 119:164** - Seven times a day do I praise thee because of thy righteous judgments.

**Psalms 119:175** - Let my soul live, and it shall praise thee; and let thy judgments help me.

**Psalms 122:5** - For there are set thrones of judgment, the thrones of the house of David.

**Psalms 143:2** - And enter not into judgment with thy servant: for in thy sight shall no man living be justified.

**Psalms 146:7** - Which executeth judgment for the oppressed: which giveth food to the hungry. The LORD looseth the prisoners:

**Psalms 147:19** - He sheweth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his judgments unto Israel.

**Psalms 147:20** - He hath not dealt so with any nation: and *as for his* judgments, they have not known them. Praise ye the LORD.

**Psalms 149:9** - To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD.

**Proverbs 1:3** - To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;

**Proverbs 2:8** - He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of his saints.

**Proverbs 2:9** - Then shalt thou understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; *yea*, every good path.

**Proverbs 8:20** - I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment:

**Proverbs 13:23** - Much food *is in* the tillage of the poor: but there is *that is* destroyed for want of judgment.

**Proverbs 16:10** - A divine sentence *is* in the lips of the king: his mouth transgresseth not in judgment.

**Proverbs 17:23** - A wicked *man* taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.

**Proverbs 18:5** - *It is* not good to accept the person of the wicked, to overthrow the righteous in judgment.

**Proverbs 19:28** - An ungodly witness scorneth judgment: and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.

**Proverbs 21:3** - To do justice and judgment *is* more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.

**Proverbs 21:7** - The robbery of the wicked shall destroy them; because they refuse to do judgment.

**Proverbs 21:15** - *It is* joy to the just to do judgment: but destruction *shall be* to the workers of iniquity.

**Proverbs 24:23** - These *things* also *belong* to the wise. *It is* not good to have respect of persons in judgment.

**Proverbs 28:5** - Evil men understand not judgment: but they that seek the LORD understand all *things*.

**Proverbs 29:4** - The king by judgment establisheth the land: but he that receiveth gifts overthroweth it.

**Proverbs 29:26** - Many seek the ruler's favour; but *every* man's judgment *cometh* from the LORD.

**Ecclesiastes 3:16** - And moreover I saw under the sun the place of judgment, *that* wickedness *was* there; and the place of righteousness, *that* iniquity *was* there.

**Ecclesiastes 5:8** - If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for *he that is* higher than the highest regardeth; and *there be* higher than they.

**Ecclesiastes 8:5** - Whoso keepeth the commandment shall feel no evil thing: and a wise man's heart discerneth both time and judgment.

**Ecclesiastes 8:6** - Because to every purpose there is time and judgment, therefore the misery of man *is* great upon him.

**Ecclesiastes 11:9** - Rejoice, O young man, in thy youth; and let thy heart cheer thee in the days of thy youth, and walk in the ways of thine heart, and in the sight of thine eyes: but know thou, that for all these *things* God will bring thee into judgment.

**Ecclesiastes 12:14** - For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether *it be* good, or whether *it be* evil.

**Isaiah 1:17** - Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow.

**Isaiah 1:27** - Zion shall be redeemed with judgment, and her converts with righteousness.

**Isaiah 3:14** - The LORD will enter into judgment with the ancients of his people, and the princes thereof: for ye have eaten up the vineyard; the spoil of the poor *is* in your houses.

**Isaiah 4:4** - When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.

**Isaiah 5:7** - For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts *is* the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for judgment, but behold oppression; for righteousness, but behold a cry.

**Isaiah 5:16** - But the LORD of hosts shall be exalted in judgment, and God that is holy shall be sanctified in righteousness.

**Isaiah 9:7** - Of the increase of *his* government and peace *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

**Isaiah 16:5** - And in mercy shall the throne be established: and he shall sit upon it in truth in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hasting righteousness.

**Isaiah 26:8** - Yea, in the way of thy judgments, O LORD, have we waited for thee; the desire of *our* soul *is* to thy name, and to the remembrance of thee.

**Isaiah 26:9** - With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early: for when thy judgments *are* in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.

**Isaiah 28:6** - And for a spirit of judgment to him that sitteth in judgment, and for strength to them that turn the battle to the gate.

**Isaiah 28:17** - Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place.

**Isaiah 30:18** - And therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the LORD *is* a God of judgment: blessed *are* all they that wait for him.

**Isaiah 32:1** - Behold, a king shall reign in righteousness, and princes shall rule in judgment.

**Isaiah 32:16** - Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field.

**Isaiah 33:5** -The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness.

**Isaiah 34:5** - For my sword shall be bathed in heaven: behold, it shall come down upon Idumea, and upon the people of my curse, to judgment.

**Isaiah 40:14** - With whom took he counsel, and *who* instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and shewed to him the way of understanding?

**Isaiah 40:27** - Why sayest thou, O Jacob, and speakest, O Israel, My way is hid from the LORD, and my judgment is passed over from my God?

**Isaiah 41:1** - Keep silence before me, O islands; and let the people renew *their* strength: let them come near; then let them speak: let us come near together to judgment.

**Isaiah 42:1** - Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, *in whom* my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles.

**Isaiah 42:3** - A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth.

**Isaiah 42:4** - He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till he have set judgment in the earth: and the isles shall wait for his law.

**Isaiah 49:4** - Then I said, I have laboured in vain, I have spent my strength for nought, and in vain: *yet* surely my judgment *is* with the LORD, and my work with my God.

**Isaiah 51:4** - Hearken unto me, my people; and give ear unto me, O my nation: for a law shall proceed from me, and I will make my judgment to rest for a light of the people.

**Isaiah 53:8** - He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

**Isaiah 54:17** - No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue *that* shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This *is* the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness *is* of me, saith the LORD.

**Isaiah 56:1** - Thus saith the LORD, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my salvation *is* near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

**Isaiah 59:8** - The way of peace they know not; and *there is* no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goeth therein shall not know peace.

**Isaiah 59:9** - Therefore is judgment far from us, neither doth justice overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, *but* we walk in darkness.

**Isaiah 59:11** - We roar all like bears, and mourn sore like doves: we look for judgment, but *there is* none; for salvation, *but* it is far off from us.

**Isaiah 59:14** - And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter.

**Isaiah 59:15** - Yea, truth faileth; and he *that* departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw *it*, and it displeased him that *there was* no judgment.

**Isaiah 61:8** - For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

**Jeremiah 1:16** - And I will utter my judgments against them touching all their wickedness, who have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, and worshipped the works of their own hands.

**Jeremiah 4:2** - And thou shalt swear, The LORD liveth, in truth, in judgment, and in righteousness; and the nations shall bless themselves in him, and in him shall they glory.

**Jeremiah 5:1** - Run ye to and fro through the streets of Jerusalem, and see now, and know, and seek in the broad places thereof, if ye can find a man, if there be *any* that executeth judgment, that seeketh the truth; and I will pardon it.

**Jeremiah 5:4** - Therefore I said, Surely these *are* poor; they are foolish: for they know not the way of the LORD, *nor* the judgment of their God.

**Jeremiah 5:5** - I will get me unto the great men, and will speak unto them; for they have known the way of the LORD, *and* the judgment of their God: but these have altogether broken the yoke, *and* burst the bonds.

**Jeremiah 7:5** - For if ye thoroughly amend your ways and your doings; if ye thoroughly execute judgment between a man and his neighbour;

**Jeremiah 8:7** - Yea, the stork in the heaven knoweth her appointed times; and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the LORD.

**Jeremiah 9:24** - But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I *am* the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these *things* I delight, saith the LORD.

**Jeremiah 10:24** - O LORD, correct me, but with judgment; not in thine anger, lest thou bring me to nothing.

**Jeremiah 12:1** - Righteous *art* thou, O LORD, when I plead with thee: yet let me talk with thee of *thy* judgments: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? *wherefore* are all they happy that deal very treacherously?

**Jeremiah 21:12** - O house of David, thus saith the LORD; Execute judgment in the morning, and deliver *him that is* spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor, lest my fury go out like fire, and burn that none can quench *it*, because of the evil of your doings.

**Jeremiah 22:3** - Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.

**Jeremiah 22:15** - Shalt thou reign, because thou closest *thyself* in cedar? did not thy father eat and drink, and do judgment and justice, *and* then *it was* well with him?

**Jeremiah 23:5** - Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

**Jeremiah 33:15** - In those days, and at that time, will I cause the Branch of righteousness to grow up unto David; and he shall execute judgment and righteousness in the land.

**Jeremiah 39:5** - But the Chaldeans' army pursued after them, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho: and when they had taken him, they brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath, where he gave judgment upon him.

**Jeremiah 48:21** - And judgment is come upon the plain country; upon Holon, and upon Jahazah, and upon Mephaath,

**Jeremiah 48:47** - Yet will I bring again the captivity of Moab in the latter days, saith the LORD. Thus far *is* the judgment of Moab.

**Jeremiah 49:12** - For thus saith the LORD; Behold, they whose judgment *was* not to drink of the cup have assuredly drunken; and *art* thou he *that* shall altogether go unpunished? thou shalt not go unpunished, but thou shalt surely drink *of it*.

**Jeremiah 51:9** - We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her, and let us go every one into his own country: for her judgment reacheth unto heaven, and is lifted up *even* to the skies.

**Jeremiah 52:9** - Then they took the king, and carried him up unto the king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath; where he gave judgment upon him.

**Ezekiel 5:6** - And she hath changed my judgments into wickedness more than the nations, and my statutes more than the countries that *are* round about her: for they have refused my judgments and my statutes, they have not walked in them.

**Ezekiel 5:7** - Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye multiplied more than the nations that *are* round about you, *and* have not walked in my statutes, neither have kept my judgments, neither have done according to the judgments of the nations that *are* round about you;

**Ezekiel 5:8** - Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I, even I, *am* against thee, and will execute judgments in the midst of thee in the sight of the nations.

**Ezekiel 11:12** - And ye shall know that I *am* the LORD: for ye have not walked in my statutes, neither executed my judgments, but have done after the manners of the heathen that *are* round about you.

**Ezekiel 18:8** - He *that* hath not given forth upon usury, neither hath taken any increase, *that* hath withdrawn his hand from iniquity, hath executed true judgment between man and man,

**Ezekiel 18:9** - Hath walked in my statutes, and hath kept my judgments, to deal truly; he *is* just, he shall surely live, saith the Lord GOD.

**Ezekiel 18:17** - *That* hath taken off his hand from the poor, *that* hath not received usury nor increase, hath executed my judgments, hath walked in my statutes; he shall not die for the iniquity of his father, he shall surely live.

**Ezekiel 20:11** - And I gave them my statutes, and shewed them my judgments, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them.

**Ezekiel 20:13** - But the house of Israel rebelled against me in the wilderness: they walked not in my statutes, and they despised my judgments, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them; and my sabbaths they greatly polluted: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, to consume them.

**Ezekiel 20:16** - Because they despised my judgments, and walked not in my statutes, but polluted my sabbaths: for their heart went after their idols.

**Ezekiel 20:18** - But I said unto their children in the wilderness, Walk ye not in the statutes of your fathers, neither observe their judgments, nor defile yourselves with their idols:

**Ezekiel 20:19** - I *am* the LORD your God; walk in my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them;

**Ezekiel 20:21** - Notwithstanding the children rebelled against me: they walked not in my statutes, neither kept my judgments to do them, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them; they polluted my sabbaths: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the wilderness.

**Ezekiel 20:24** - Because they had not executed my judgments, but had despised my statutes, and had polluted my sabbaths, and their eyes were after their fathers' idols.

**Ezekiel 20:25** - Wherefore I gave them also statutes *that were* not good, and judgments whereby they should not live;

**Ezekiel 23:24** - And they shall come against thee with chariots, wagons, and wheels, and with an assembly of people, *which* shall set against thee buckler and shield and helmet round about: and I will set judgment before them, and they shall judge thee according to their judgments.

**Ezekiel 34:16** - I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up *that which* was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick: but I will destroy the fat and the strong; I will feed them with judgment.

**Ezekiel 36:27** - And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do *them*.

**Ezekiel 37:24** - And David my servant *shall be* king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them.

**Ezekiel 39:21** - And I will set my glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid upon them.

**Ezekiel 45:9** - Thus saith the Lord GOD; Let it suffice you, O princes of Israel: remove violence and spoil, and execute judgment and justice, take away your exactions from my people, saith the Lord GOD.

**Daniel 9:5** - We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments:

**Hosea 2:19** - And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

**Hosea 5:1** - Hear ye this, O priests; and hearken, ye house of Israel; and give ye ear, O house of the king; for judgment *is* toward you, because ye have been a snare on Mizpah, and a net spread upon Tabor.

**Hosea 5:11** - Ephraim *is* oppressed *and* broken in judgment, because he willingly walked after the commandment.

**Hosea 6:5** - Therefore have I hewed *them* by the prophets; I have slain them by the words of my mouth: and thy judgments *are as* the light *that* goeth forth.

**Hosea 10:4** - They have spoken words, swearing falsely in making a covenant: thus judgment springeth up as hemlock in the furrows of the field.

**Hosea 12:6** - Therefore turn thou to thy God: keep mercy and judgment, and wait on thy God continually.

**Amos 5:7** - Ye who turn judgment to wormwood, and leave off righteousness in the earth,

**Amos 5:15** - Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph.

**Amos 5:24** - But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream.

**Amos 6:12** - Shall horses run upon the rock? will *one* plow *there* with oxen? for ye have turned judgment into gall, and the fruit of righteousness into hemlock:

**Micah 3:1** - And I said, Hear, I pray you, O heads of Jacob, and ye princes of the house of Israel; *Is it* not for you to know judgment?

**Micah 3:8** - But truly I am full of power by the spirit of the LORD, and of judgment, and of might, to declare unto Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin.

**Micah 3:9** - Hear this, I pray you, ye heads of the house of Jacob, and princes of the house of Israel, that abhor judgment, and pervert all equity.

**Micah 7:9** - I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the light, *and* I shall behold his righteousness.

**Habakkuk 1:4** - Therefore the law is slacked, and judgment doth never go forth: for the wicked doth compass about the righteous; therefore wrong judgment proceedeth.

**Habakkuk 1:7** - They *are* terrible and dreadful: their judgment and their dignity shall proceed of themselves.

**Habakkuk 1:12** - *Art* thou not from everlasting, O LORD my God, mine Holy One? we shall not die. O LORD, thou hast ordained them for judgment; and, O mighty God, thou hast established them for correction.

**Zephaniah 2:3** - Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

**Zephaniah 3:5** - The just LORD *is* in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning doth he bring his judgment to light, he faileth not; but the unjust knoweth no shame.

**Zephaniah 3:15** - The LORD hath taken away thy judgments, he hath cast out thine enemy: the king of Israel, *even* the LORD, *is* in the midst of thee: thou shalt not see evil any more.

**Zechariah 7:9** - Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Execute true judgment, and shew mercy and compassions every man to his brother:

**Zechariah 8:16** - These *are* the things that ye shall do; Speak ye every man the truth to his neighbour; execute the judgment of truth and peace in your gates:

**Malachi 2:17** - Ye have wearied the LORD with your words. Yet ye say, Wherein have we wearied *him*? When ye say, Every one that doeth evil *is* good in the sight of the LORD, and he delighteth in them; or, Where *is* the God of judgment?

**Malachi 3:5** - And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in *his* wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger *from his right*, and fear not me, saith the LORD of hosts.

**Malachi 4:4** - Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, *with* the statutes and judgments.

**2 Chronicles 20:9** - If, *when* evil cometh upon us, as the sword, judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we stand before this house, and in thy presence, (for thy name *is* in this house,) and cry unto thee in our affliction, then thou wilt hear and help.

**Ezekiel 23:10** - These discovered her nakedness: they took her sons and her daughters, and slew her with the sword: and she became famous among women; for they had executed judgment upon her.

---

**Shâpaţ, Hebrew Strong's #8199**, is a verb found 203 times, translated as judge (v) (119), judge (n) (60), plead (11), avenged (2), condemn (2), execute (2), judgment (2), defend (1), deliver (1), *miscellaneous translations* (3). It is translated as "judgment" in the following verses:

**2 Chronicles 22:8** - And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

**Ezekiel 44:24** - And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; *and* they shall judge it according to my judgments: and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all mine assemblies; and they shall hallow my sabbaths.

---

**Shepheth, Hebrew Strong's #8201**, is a noun found 16 times, translated as judgment (2) and judgments (14) in the following verses:

**Exodus 6:6** - Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I *am* the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:

**Exodus 7:4** - But Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you, that I may lay my hand upon Egypt, and bring forth mine armies, *and* my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments.

**Exodus 12:12** - For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I *am* the LORD.

**Numbers 33:4** - For the Egyptians buried all *their* firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD executed judgments.

**2 Chronicles 24:24** - For the army of the Syrians came with a small company of men, and the LORD delivered a very great host into their hand, because they had forsaken the LORD God of their fathers. So they executed judgment against Joash.

**Proverbs 19:29** - Judgments are prepared for scorners, and stripes for the back of fools.

**Ezekiel 5:10** - Therefore the fathers shall eat the sons in the midst of thee, and the sons shall eat their fathers; and I will execute judgments in thee, and the whole remnant of thee will I scatter into all the winds.

**Ezekiel 5:15** - So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, an instruction and an astonishment unto the nations that *are* round about thee, when I shall execute judgments in thee in anger and in fury and in furious rebukes. I the LORD have spoken *it*.

**Ezekiel 11:9** - And I will bring you out of the midst thereof, and deliver you into the hands of strangers, and will execute judgments among you.

**Ezekiel 14:21** - For thus saith the Lord GOD; How much more when I send my four sore judgments upon Jerusalem, the sword, and the famine, and the noisome beast, and the pestilence, to cut off from it man and beast?

**Ezekiel 16:41** - And they shall burn thine houses with fire, and execute judgments upon thee in the sight of many women: and I will cause thee to cease from playing the harlot, and thou also shalt give no hire any more.



**Ezekiel 25:11** - And I will execute judgments upon Moab; and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.

**Ezekiel 28:22** - And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I *am* against thee, O Zidon; and I will be glorified in the midst of thee: and they shall know that I *am* the LORD, when I shall have executed judgments in her, and shall be sanctified in her.

**Ezekiel 28:26** - And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yea, they shall dwell with confidence, when I have executed judgments upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that I *am* the LORD their God.

**Ezekiel 30:14** - And I will make Pathros desolate, and will set fire in Zoan, and will execute judgments in No.

**Ezekiel 30:19** - Thus will I execute judgments in Egypt: and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.

---
