## "Zion" and "Sion" as found in the

## Old Testament of the King James Version of the Holy Bible

אַיוֹן, Hebrew Strong's #6726, is translated as "Zion" and "Sion" 154 times in the OT, as follows:

- **2 Samuel 5:7** Nevertheless David took the strong hold of <u>Zion</u>: the same *is* the city of David.
- **1 Kings 8:1** Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto king Solomon in Jerusalem, that they might bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which *is* Zion.
- **2 Kings 19:21** This *is* the word that the LORD hath spoken concerning him; The virgin the daughter of <u>Zion</u> hath despised thee, *and* laughed thee to scorn; the daughter of Jerusalem hath shaken her head at thee.
- **2 Kings 19:31** For out of Jerusalem shall go forth a remnant, and they that escape out of mount <u>Zion</u>: the zeal of the LORD *of hosts* shall do this.
- **1 Chronicles 11:5** And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, Thou shalt not come hither. Nevertheless David took the castle of Zion, which *is* the city of David.
- **2 Chronicles 5:2** Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which *is* Zion.
- **Psalm 2:6** Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.
- **Psalm 9:11** Sing praises to the LORD, which dwelleth in <u>Zion</u>: declare among the people his doings.
- **Psalm 9:14 -** That I may shew forth all thy praise in the gates of the daughter of <u>Zion</u>: I will rejoice in thy salvation.
- **Psalm 14:7 -** Oh that the salvation of Israel *were come* out of <u>Zion!</u> when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, *and* Israel shall be glad.
- **Psalm 20:2 -** Send thee help from the sanctuary, and strengthen thee out of Zion;
- **Psalm 48:2 -** Beautiful for situation, the joy of the whole earth, *is* mount <u>Zion</u>, *on* the sides of the north, the city of the great King.
- **Psalm 48:11 -** Let mount <u>Zion</u> rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of thy judgments.
- **Psalm 48:12 -** Walk about Zion, and go round about her: tell the towers thereof.
- **Psalm 50:2 -** Out of **Zion**, the perfection of beauty, God hath shined.

**Psalm 51:18 -** Do good in thy good pleasure unto **Zion**: build thou the walls of Jerusalem.

**Psalm 53:6 -** Oh that the salvation of Israel *were come* out of <u>Zion!</u> When God bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, *and* Israel shall be glad.

Psalm 65:1 - Praise waiteth for thee, O God, in Sion: and unto thee shall the vow be performed.

**Psalm 69:35 -** For God will save <u>Zion</u>, and will build the cities of Judah: that they may dwell there, and have it in possession.

**Psalm 74:2 -** Remember thy congregation, *which* thou hast purchased of old; the rod of thine inheritance, *which* thou hast redeemed; this mount Zion, wherein thou hast dwelt.

**Psalm 76:2 -** In Salem also is his tabernacle, and his dwelling place in **Zion**.

**Psalm 78:68 -** But chose the tribe of Judah, the mount Zion which he loved.

**Psalm 84:7 -** They go from strength to strength, *every one of them* in <u>Zion</u> appeareth before God.

**Psalm 87:2 -** The LORD loveth the gates of Zion more than all the dwellings of Jacob.

**Psalm 87:5 -** And of <u>Zion</u> it shall be said, This and that man was born in her: and the highest himself shall establish her.

**Psalm 97:8 -** Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah rejoiced because of thy judgments, O LORD.

**Psalm 99:2 -** The LORD *is* great in Zion; and he *is* high above all the people.

**Psalm 102:13 -** Thou shalt arise, *and* have mercy upon <u>Zion</u>: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come.

Psalm 102:16 - When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory.

Psalm 102:21 - To declare the name of the LORD in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem;

**Psalm 110:2 -** The LORD shall send the rod of thy strength out of <u>Zion</u>: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies.

**Psalm 125:1 -** They that trust in the LORD *shall be* as mount <u>Zion</u>, *which* cannot be removed, *but* abideth for ever.

**Psalm 126:1 -** When the LORD turned again the captivity of <u>Zion</u>, we were like them that dream.

**Psalm 128:5 -** The LORD shall bless thee out of <u>Zion</u>: and thou shalt see the good of Jerusalem all the days of thy life.

**Psalm 129:5 -** Let them all be confounded and turned back that hate **Zion**.

- **Psalm 132:13 -** For the LORD hath chosen Zion; he hath desired *it* for his habitation.
- **Psalm 133:3 -** As the dew of Hermon, *and as the dew* that descended upon the mountains of <u>Zion</u>: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, *even* life for evermore.
- Psalm 134:3 The LORD that made heaven and earth bless thee out of Zion.
- **Psalm 135:21 -** Blessed be the LORD out of <u>Zion</u>, which dwelleth at Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD.
- **Psalm 137:1 -** By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, yea, we wept, when we remembered Zion.
- **Psalm 137:3 -** For there they that carried us away captive required of us a song; and they that wasted us *required of us* mirth, *saying*, Sing us *one* of the songs of <u>Zion</u>.
- **Psalm 146:10 -** The LORD shall reign for ever, *even* thy God, O <u>Zion</u>, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD.
- **Psalm 147:12 -** Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem; praise thy God, O Zion.
- **Psalm 149:2 -** Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of <u>Zion</u> be joyful in their King.
- **Song of Songs 3:11 -** Go forth, O ye daughters of <u>Zion</u>, and behold king Solomon with the crown wherewith his mother crowned him in the day of his espousals, and in the day of the gladness of his heart.
- **Isaiah 1:8 -** And the daughter of <u>Zion</u> is left as a cottage in a vineyard, as a lodge in a garden of cucumbers, as a besieged city.
- **Isaiah 1:27 Zion** shall be redeemed with judgment, and her converts with righteousness.
- **Isaiah 2:3 -** And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of <u>Zion</u> shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
- **Isaiah 3:16 -** Moreover the LORD saith, Because the daughters of <u>Zion</u> are haughty, and walk with stretched forth necks and wanton eyes, walking and mincing *as* they go, and making a tinkling with their feet:
- **Isaiah 3:17 -** Therefore the Lord will smite with a scab the crown of the head of the daughters of <u>Zion</u>, and the LORD will discover their secret parts.
- **Isaiah 4:3 -** And it shall come to pass, *that he that is* left in <u>Zion</u>, and *he that* remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, *even* every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem:
- **Isaiah 4:4 -** When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of <u>Zion</u>, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.

- **Isaiah 4:5 -** And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount <u>Zion</u>, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory *shall be* a defence.
- **Isaiah 8:18 -** Behold, I and the children whom the LORD hath given me *are* for signs and for wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth in mount Zion.
- **Isaiah 10:12 -** Wherefore it shall come to pass, *that* when the Lord hath performed his whole work upon mount <u>Zion</u> and on Jerusalem, I will punish the fruit of the stout heart of the king of Assyria, and the glory of his high looks.
- **Isaiah 10:24 -** Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD of hosts, O my people that dwellest in <u>Zion</u>, be not afraid of the Assyrian: he shall smite thee with a rod, and shall lift up his staff against thee, after the manner of Egypt.
- **Isaiah 10:32 -** As yet shall he remain at Nob that day: he shall shake his hand *against* the mount of the daughter of <u>Zion</u>, the hill of Jerusalem.
- **Isaiah 12:6 -** Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of <u>Zion</u>: for great *is* the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee.
- **Isaiah 14:32 -** What shall *one* then answer the messengers of the nation? That the LORD hath founded <u>Zion</u>, and the poor of his people shall trust in it.
- **Isaiah 16:1 -** Send ye the lamb to the ruler of the land from Sela to the wilderness, unto the mount of the daughter of <u>Zion</u>.
- **Isaiah 18:7 -** In that time shall the present be brought unto the LORD of hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, the mount <u>Zion</u>.
- **Isaiah 24:23 -** Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed, when the LORD of hosts shall reign in mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients gloriously.
- **Isaiah 28:16 -** Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in <u>Zion</u> for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner *stone*, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste.
- **Isaiah 29:8 -** It shall even be as when an hungry *man* dreameth, and, behold, he eateth; but he awaketh, and his soul is empty: or as when a thirsty man dreameth, and, behold, he drinketh; but he awaketh, and, behold, he is faint, and his soul hath appetite: so shall the multitude of all the nations be, that fight against mount <u>Zion</u>.
- **Isaiah 30:19 -** For the people shall dwell in <u>Zion</u> at Jerusalem: thou shalt weep no more: he will be very gracious unto thee at the voice of thy cry; when he shall hear it, he will answer thee.
- **Isaiah 31:4 -** For thus hath the LORD spoken unto me, Like as the lion and the young lion roaring on his prey, when a multitude of shepherds is called forth against him, *he* will not be afraid of their voice, nor abase himself for the noise of them: so shall the LORD of hosts come down to fight for mount <u>Zion</u>, and for the hill thereof.

- **Isaiah 31:9 -** And he shall pass over to his strong hold for fear, and his princes shall be afraid of the ensign, saith the LORD, whose fire *is* in <u>Zion</u>, and his furnace in Jerusalem.
- **Isaiah 33:5 -** The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled <u>Zion</u> with judgment and righteousness.
- **Isaiah 33:14 -** The sinners in <u>Zion</u> are afraid; fearfulness hath surprised the hypocrites. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?
- **Isaiah 33:20 -** Look upon <u>Zion</u>, the city of our solemnities: thine eyes shall see Jerusalem a quiet habitation, a tabernacle *that* shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken.
- **Isaiah 34:8 -** For *it is* the day of the LORD'S vengeance, *and* the year of recompences for the controversy of <u>Zion</u>.
- **Isaiah 35:10 -** And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to <u>Zion</u> with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.
- **Isaiah 37:22 -** This *is* the word which the LORD hath spoken concerning him; The virgin, the daughter of <u>Zion</u>, hath despised thee, *and* laughed thee to scorn; the daughter of Jerusalem hath shaken her head at thee.
- **Isaiah 37:32 -** For out of Jerusalem shall go forth a remnant, and they that escape out of mount Zion: the zeal of the LORD of hosts shall do this.
- **Isaiah 40:9 -** O Zion, that bringest good tidings, get thee up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, that bringest good tidings, lift up thy voice with strength; lift *it* up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah, Behold your God!
- **Isaiah 41:27 -** The first *shall say* to <u>Zion</u>, Behold, behold them: and I will give to Jerusalem one that bringeth good tidings.
- **Isaiah 46:13 -** I bring near my righteousness; it shall not be far off, and my salvation shall not tarry: and I will place salvation in <u>Zion</u> for Israel my glory.
- Isaiah 49:14 But Zion said, The LORD hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me.
- **Isaiah 51:3 -** For the LORD shall comfort <u>Zion</u>: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody.
- **Isaiah 51:11 -** Therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall return, and come with singing unto <u>Zion</u>; and everlasting joy *shall be* upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; *and* sorrow and mourning shall flee away.
- **Isaiah 51:16 -** And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou *art* my people.

- **Isaiah 52:1 -** Awake, awake; put on thy strength, O <u>Zion</u>; put on thy beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city: for henceforth there shall no more come into thee the uncircumcised and the unclean.
- **Isaiah 52:2 -** Shake thyself from the dust; arise, *and* sit down, O Jerusalem: loose thyself from the bands of thy neck, O captive daughter of <u>Zion</u>.
- **Isaiah 52:7 -** How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth!
- **Isaiah 52:8 -** Thy watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the LORD shall bring again <u>Zion</u>.
- **Isaiah 59:20 -** And the Redeemer shall come to <u>Zion</u>, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD.
- **Isaiah 60:14 -** The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come bending unto thee; and all they that despised thee shall bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet; and they shall call thee, The city of the LORD, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel.
- **Isaiah 61:3 -** To appoint unto them that mourn in <u>Zion</u>, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
- **Isaiah 62:11 -** Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of <u>Zion</u>, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward *is* with him, and his work before him.
- **Isaiah 64:10 -** Thy holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation.
- **Isaiah 66:8 -** Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? *or* shall a nation be born at once? for as soon as <u>Zion</u> travailed, she brought forth her children.
- **Jeremiah 3:14 -** Turn, O backsliding children, saith the LORD; for I am married unto you: and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, and I will bring you to **Zion**:
- **Jeremiah 4:6 -** Set up the standard toward <u>Zion</u>: retire, stay not: for I will bring evil from the north, and a great destruction.
- **Jeremiah 4:31 -** For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, *and* the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of <u>Zion</u>, *that* bewaileth herself, *that* spreadeth her hands, *saying*, Woe *is* me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.
- **Jeremiah 6:2 -** I have likened the daughter of **Zion** to a comely and delicate *woman*.
- **Jeremiah 6:23 -** They shall lay hold on bow and spear; they *are* cruel, and have no mercy; their voice roareth like the sea; and they ride upon horses, set in array as men for war against thee, O daughter of Zion.

- **Jeremiah 8:19 -** Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of my people because of them that dwell in a far country: *Is* not the LORD in <u>Zion</u>? *is* not her king in her? Why have they provoked me to anger with their graven images, *and* with strange vanities?
- **Jeremiah 9:19 -** For a voice of wailing is heard out of <u>Zion</u>, How are we spoiled! we are greatly confounded, because we have forsaken the land, because our dwellings have cast *us* out.
- **Jeremiah 14:19 -** Hast thou utterly rejected Judah? hath thy soul lothed <u>Zion</u>? why hast thou smitten us, and *there is* no healing for us? we looked for peace, and *there is* no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble!
- **Jeremiah 26:18 -** Micah the Morasthite prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and spake to all the people of Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; <u>Zion</u> shall be plowed *like* a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house as the high places of a forest.
- **Jeremiah 30:17 -** For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, *saying*, This *is* <u>Zion</u>, whom no man seeketh after.
- **Jeremiah 31:6 -** For there shall be a day, *that* the watchmen upon the mount Ephraim shall cry, Arise ye, and let us go up to Zion unto the LORD our God.
- **Jeremiah 31:12 -** Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of <u>Zion</u>, and shall flow together to the goodness of the LORD, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and their soul shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more at all.
- **Jeremiah 50:5 -** They shall ask the way to <u>Zion</u> with their faces thitherward, *saying*, Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual covenant *that* shall not be forgotten.
- **Jeremiah 50:28 -** The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of Babylon, to declare in **Zion** the vengeance of the LORD our God, the vengeance of his temple.
- **Jeremiah 51:10 -** The LORD hath brought forth our righteousness: come, and let us declare in Zion the work of the LORD our God.
- **Jeremiah 51:24 -** And I will render unto Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their evil that they have done in <u>Zion</u> in your sight, saith the LORD.
- **Jeremiah 51:35 -** The violence done to me and to my flesh *be* upon Babylon, shall the inhabitant of <u>Zion</u> say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say.
- **Lamentations 1:4 -** The ways of <u>Zion</u> do mourn, because none come to the solemn feasts: all her gates are desolate: her priests sigh, her virgins are afflicted, and she *is* in bitterness.
- **Lamentations 1:6 -** And from the daughter of <u>Zion</u> all her beauty is departed: her princes are become like harts *that* find no pasture, and they are gone without strength before the pursuer.

**Lamentations 1:17 -** Zion spreadeth forth her hands, *and there is* none to comfort her: the LORD hath commanded concerning Jacob, *that* his adversaries *should be* round about him: Jerusalem is as a menstruous woman among them.

**Lamentations 2:1 -** How hath the Lord covered the daughter of <u>Zion</u> with a cloud in his anger, and cast down from heaven unto the earth the beauty of Israel, and remembered not his footstool in the day of his anger!

**Lamentations 2:4 -** He hath bent his bow like an enemy: he stood with his right hand as an adversary, and slew all *that were* pleasant to the eye in the tabernacle of the daughter of <u>Zion</u>: he poured out his fury like fire.

**Lamentations 2:6 -** And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as *if it were of* a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in <u>Zion</u>, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

**Lamentations 2:8 -** The LORD hath purposed to destroy the wall of the daughter of <u>Zion</u>: he hath stretched out a line, he hath not withdrawn his hand from destroying: therefore he made the rampart and the wall to lament; they languished together.

**Lamentations 2:10 -** The elders of the daughter of <u>Zion</u> sit upon the ground, *and* keep silence: they have cast up dust upon their heads; they have girded themselves with sackcloth: the virgins of Jerusalem hang down their heads to the ground.

**Lamentations 2:13 -** What thing shall I take to witness for thee? what thing shall I liken to thee, O daughter of Jerusalem? what shall I equal to thee, that I may comfort thee, O virgin daughter of Zion? for thy breach *is* great like the sea: who can heal thee?

**Lamentations 2:18 -** Their heart cried unto the Lord, O wall of the daughter of <u>Zion</u>, let tears run down like a river day and night: give thyself no rest; let not the apple of thine eye cease.

**Lamentations 4:2 -** The precious sons of <u>Zion</u>, comparable to fine gold, how are they esteemed as earthen pitchers, the work of the hands of the potter!

**Lamentations 4:11 -** The LORD hath accomplished his fury; he hath poured out his fierce anger, and hath kindled a fire in <u>Zion</u>, and it hath devoured the foundations thereof.

**Lamentations 4:22 -** The punishment of thine iniquity is accomplished, O daughter of <u>Zion</u>; he will no more carry thee away into captivity: he will visit thine iniquity, O daughter of Edom; he will discover thy sins.

**Lamentations 5:11 -** They ravished the women in Zion, and the maids in the cities of Judah.

**Lamentations 5:18 -** Because of the mountain of <u>Zion</u>, which is desolate, the foxes walk upon it.

**Joel 2:1 -** Blow ye the trumpet in <u>Zion</u>, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD cometh, for *it is* nigh at hand;

**Joel 2:15 -** Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly:

- **Joel 2:23 -** Be glad then, ye children of <u>Zion</u>, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first *month*.
- **Joel 2:32 -** And it shall come to pass, *that* whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount <u>Zion</u> and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.
- **Joel 3:16 -** The LORD also shall roar out of <u>Zion</u>, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD *will be* the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel.
- **Joel 3:17 -** So shall ye know that I *am* the LORD your God dwelling in <u>Zion</u>, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.
- Joel 3:21 For I will cleanse their blood that I have not cleansed: for the LORD dwelleth in Zion.
- **Amos 1:2 -** And he said, The LORD will roar from <u>Zion</u>, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither.
- **Amos 6:1 -** Woe to them *that are* at ease in <u>Zion</u>, and trust in the mountain of Samaria, *which* are named chief of the nations, to whom the house of Israel came!
- **Obadiah 1:17 -** But upon mount <u>Zion</u> shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; and the house of Jacob shall possess their possessions.
- **Obadiah 1:21 -** And saviours shall come up on mount <u>Zion</u> to judge the mount of Esau; and the kingdom shall be the LORD'S.
- **Micah 1:13 -** O thou inhabitant of Lachish, bind the chariot to the swift beast: she *is* the beginning of the sin to the daughter of Zion: for the transgressions of Israel were found in thee.
- **Micah 3:10 -** They build up Zion with blood, and Jerusalem with iniquity.
- **Micah 3:12 -** Therefore shall <u>Zion</u> for your sake be plowed *as* a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house as the high places of the forest.
- **Micah 4:2 -** And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of <u>Zion</u>, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
- **Micah 4:7 -** And I will make her that halted a remnant, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the LORD shall reign over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever.
- **Micah 4:8 -** And thou, O tower of the flock, the strong hold of the daughter of <u>Zion</u>, unto thee shall it come, even the first dominion; the kingdom shall come to the daughter of Jerusalem.
- **Micah 4:10 -** Be in pain, and labour to bring forth, O daughter of <u>Zion</u>, like a woman in travail: for now shalt thou go forth out of the city, and thou shalt dwell in the field, and thou shalt go

even to Babylon; there shalt thou be delivered; there the LORD shall redeem thee from the hand of thine enemies.

**Micah 4:11 -** Now also many nations are gathered against thee, that say, Let her be defiled, and let our eye look upon <u>Zion</u>.

**Micah 4:13 -** Arise and thresh, O daughter of <u>Zion</u>: for I will make thine horn iron, and I will make thy hoofs brass: and thou shalt beat in pieces many people: and I will consecrate their gain unto the LORD, and their substance unto the Lord of the whole earth.

**Zephaniah 3:14 -** Sing, O daughter of <u>Zion</u>; shout, O Israel; be glad and rejoice with all the heart, O daughter of Jerusalem.

**Zephaniah 3:16 -** In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem, Fear thou not: *and to* <u>Zion</u>, Let not thine hands be slack.

**Zechariah 1:14 -** So the angel that communed with me said unto me, Cry thou, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; I am jealous for Jerusalem and for <u>Zion</u> with a great jealousy.

**Zechariah 1:17 -** Cry yet, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and the LORD shall yet comfort <u>Zion</u>, and shall yet choose Jerusalem.

**Zechariah 2:7 -** Deliver thyself, O <u>Zion</u>, that dwellest *with* the daughter of Babylon.

**Zechariah 2:10 -** Sing and rejoice, O daughter of <u>Zion</u>: for, lo, I come, and I will dwell in the midst of thee, saith the LORD.

**Zechariah 8:2 -** Thus saith the LORD of hosts; I was jealous for <u>Zion</u> with great jealousy, and I was jealous for her with great fury.

**Zechariah 8:3 -** Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto <u>Zion</u>, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain.

**Zechariah 9:9 -** Rejoice greatly, O daughter of <u>Zion</u>; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he *is* just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

**Zechariah 9:13 -** When I have bent Judah for me, filled the bow with Ephraim, and raised up thy sons, O <u>Zion</u>, against thy sons, O Greece, and made thee as the sword of a mighty man.
